Thank you for registering to volunteer for the 2005 Dive! Put-in-Bay Harbor Clean-Up on Monday, September 19, 2005 at Put-in-Bay, OH. Please send your completed form to Dive! Put-in-Bay, PO Box 250, Put-in-Bay, OH 43456. Upon receiving your pre-registration, we will send you a confirmation packet with a Miller Ferry schedule, Put-in-Bay Island Guide and any materials needed for ferry passage and transportation to and from the ferry dock on the island.

This year's underwater clean-up is being coordinated by the Dive! Put-in-Bay Harbor Clean-Up event committee consisting of the New Wave Dive Center and Patrix Scuba, Port Clinton, the Ohio Council of Skin and Scuba Divers Inc., The Ohio State University's Stone Lab and the Put-in-Bay Chamber of Commerce and member businesses in conjunction with the Village of Put-in-Bay, the DeRivera Park Trust, Miller Boat Line and Island Transportation.

Registration will begin at 9 a.m. This means you need to board a Miller ferry no later than 8:30 a.m. to get downtown at a reasonable time. Miller's will have a list of pre-registered volunteers and will check your name off after you receive a boarding pass at the Catawba Dock.

Once on the island, the Island Tour Train will transport divers and their equipment and any land support volunteers who arrive on the island at the Lime Kiln Dock by 9:30 a.m. Please report to the Registration Center in DeRivera Park immediately after arriving downtown to check-in and receive any needed registration materials and your t-shirt. You will be given an assignment by our Operations and Land Coordinator, Sandy Heschel.

Lunch will be served in the park following the clean-up and prizes will be awarded afterwards. You are invited to spend the afternoon enjoying the island. A tram will pick up divers and their equipment at the park immediately following the event and again at 4:30 p.m. to return to Miller Boat Line's Lime Kiln Dock for the return trip to the mainland. Land volunteers will be transported by tram or by the downtown bus. You may stay later, but you will be responsible for paying your transportation back to the ferry dock (2.5 miles from downtown).
